
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


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Common Palliative Care Indicators

- Complex medical issues
- Uncontrolled symptoms related to underlying disease
- Recurrent ER visits
- Multiple hospitalizations
- Hospital readmission within 30 days
- Vomiting/Nausea
- Increased pain
- Shortness of breath
- Frequent infections
- Weight loss
- Non-healing wounds
- Decline in ability to function
- Cognitive decline
- Inadequate home, social, family support
